1	7.3.2	An applicant may submit a claim for disbursement of incentive on <b>annual basis</b> . Claims for any period shall be made only once, unless withdrawn, and no subsequent part claims shall be allowed for the said period.	An applicant may submit a claim for disbursement of incentive on <b>Quarterly/ Half Yearly/ Annual basis</b> . Claims for any period shall be made only once, unless withdrawn, and no subsequent part claims shall be allowed for the said period.
2	7.3.3	Claims for disbursement of incentive shall be filed along with supporting documents <b>within one month of the closure of the given financial year</b> . If the claim is found to be in order, 75% of it shall be released and the remaining 25% shall be released after submission of final audited accounts of the Company.	Claims for disbursement of incentive shall be filed along with supporting documents <b>immediately after the end of the quarter / half-year / year, within one month</b> . If the claim is found to be in order, 75% of it shall be released and the remaining 25% shall be released after submission of final audited accounts of the Company.
3	7.3.7	The PMA shall process claim for disbursement of incentive <b>within 60 days</b> from the date of receipt of such claim and make appropriate recommendations to DoP	The PMA shall process claim for disbursement of incentive within <b>30-45 days</b> from the date of receipt of such claim and make appropriate recommendations to DoP
